

## Washington Search for Young Scholars

Now in its third year, the Washington Search for Young Scholars (WSYS-2005) aims to identify our state's most academically capable 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students, to honor them with recognition, and to work with them, their families, and their schools to explore and expand advanced educational opportunities here in Washington. WSYS is modeled after other academic talents searches: students who score very high on achievement tests are invited to register with WSYS and to then take even harder tests designed for older students. Students who continue to score high on the older students' tests are often found to be great candidates for accelerated classes, or summer academic experiences.
