I move that the Seattle School Board approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Seattle School District and Seattle/King County Building and Construction Trades Council Plumbers and Pipefitters Local N0.32.

ISSUE

The Seattle School District and Seattle/King County Building and Construction Trades Council Plumbers and Pipefitters Local No.32 agree that a position within the Bargaining Unit be reclassified as a Licensed Sprinkler Fitter for compliance with the City of Seattle Fire Department standard.

POLICY IMPLICATION

\$4 stipend for one FTE equals \$8,320 per year
