TITLE AND BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Superintendent's Employment Agreement For Introduction: June 17, 2009
For Action: July 1, 2009

Issue

The Board of Directors annually reviews the performance of the Superintendent and determines whether or not to extend the Superintendent's employment contract for a three-year term and increase her salary.

RECOMMENDED MOTION

I move that the Board of Directors accept the Executive Committee's recommendations to amend the Superintendent's employment agreement as follows:

1. Extend the existing employment agreement between the School District and Dr. Goodloe-Johnson to June 30, 2012;
2. Maintain Dr. Goodloe-Johnson's current salary with no salary increase or cost of living increase;
3. Increase Dr. Goodloe-Johnson's retirement plan contribution from \$20,000 per year to \$22,000 per year for her participation in the District's 403(b) program.

I further move that the Board provide President DeBell with the authority necessary to implement this action.

RECOMMENDATION

The Board of Directors has evaluated Superintendent Goodloe-Johnson's performance. It is the recommendation of the Executive Committee to extend the Superintendent's employment agreement and to increase her retirement plan contribution as stated in the motion.
