**Field Testing Update**

Frank Greer reported that the completed poll analysis will be a lengthy report plus a PowerPoint and an Executive Summary. Most of the summary results were shared with the committee. The poll affirmed the recommendations of the committee. 2/3 of Seattle residents support every component of the Committee's proposed plan. It was a positive and intensive process. The data will be an appendix to the committee's final report.

Steve Nielsen reported that the Board directed staff to add resources for high school six periods in 06-07, using new I-728 reserves.

**Final Draft Review**

- Add multicultural references throughout document
- Acknowledge hard work of District staff
- Add ongoing commitment to cultural competency
- Add language recommending District review how other districts implement WSF models
- Clarify full day K language
- Recommend the city work with the district marketing schools and neighborhoods
- Call for a report on progress
