Project Title and Description

Cleveland High School Historic Renovation, Demolition and New Construction Project (CHS Project)

The CHS Project would involve selective demolition, renovations and additions to the existing 1927 landmark building, and construction of two additions (gymnasium and classroom addition). These project components are part of the *Building Excellence Phase (BEX) II, Capital Improvement Program*, and were analyzed on a programmatic level in the SEIS for BEX II.¹ In addition, the CHS Project includes demolition and relocation of the gymnasium to the corner of S. Lucile St. and 15th Avenue S., and construction and placement of the classroom addition. These additional elements are analyzed in this Supplemental EIS.
