Sealed Bids will be received by Seattle Public Schools ("SPS" or "Owner") through and including 2:00 p.m. on November 20, 2009 at the Seattle Public Schools' John Stanford Center, Contracting Services Section, 2445 Third Avenue South, Seattle, WA 98134 for Roxhill 2010 Upgrades. The work will include, but not be limited to, windows, mechanical, flooring, window shades, stage drapes and library upgrade. The cost range is \$350,000 to \$500,000. Shortly after 2:00 p.m. bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the day and hour stated above will not receive consideration. Owner reserves the right to postpone the Bid opening.

The Project site is available for inspection by prospective bidders at a pre-bid site meeting and walk-through at 2:00 p.m. on October 28, 2009, at Roxhill Elementary School, 9430 30<sup>th</sup> Ave SW, Seattle, WA. A surety company bid bond on a form acceptable to Owner, a cashier's check or a certified check payable to the order of Seattle Public Schools shall accompany each bid in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the Base Bid. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received.

No bidder may withdraw its bid after the hour set for the opening thereof, unless the award of the contract is delayed for a period exceeding ninety (90) days.
