Seattle Public Schools will make available on October 11, 2005 an environmental checklist and determination of non-significance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA, Chapter 197-11 WAC) for an athletic field project at Franklin High School.

Work is currently scheduled for spring/summer 2006. The existing field and track surfaces will be renovated, including installation of new synthetic turf field surfacing and rubberized running track surfacing. Associated with the new surfaces will be improvements to the drainage system, additions to and partial replacement of chain-link fencing, and perimeter paving. The proposal does *not* include any field lighting.

After review of the completed environmental checklist and other site-specific information, Seattle Public Schools has determined that the project will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
