

VACCINES REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ATTENDANCE, GRADES K-12 2007 – 2008

(Month, Day & Year are Required)

Exemptions:

- Medical exemption requires a physician's signature.
- Personal or religious exemption requires parent or guardian signature.

More detailed information:

1. Children who are past their 7th birthday should not be given DTaP vaccine. Such children can fulfill this requirement with three doses of DTaP, DT, Td, or a combination of these, provided the last dose is on or after the fourth birthday. Tdap can be given after age 10.
2. **Tdap is required for students age 11 or older who have not had a tetanus-containing vaccination within the past 5 years.** Tdap cannot be received before age 10 or within two years of receiving a tetanus-containing vaccination.
3. **Four doses given at appropriate ages & intervals will be accepted as an exception.** Students age 18 or older are not required to have the vaccine.
4. Laboratory evidence of immunity to measles, mumps or rubella may be substituted for the vaccine.
5. For those beginning or completing the series: the second dose 1-3 months after the first; the third dose 2-6 months after the second and on or after six months of age. The series must not be completed in less than four months but must be completed within nine months after school registration. (There is no maximum interval between doses. The series does not need to be restarted if an interval was longer than the recommended one.)
6. **Parent statement that the student has had chickenpox will be an exception to the varicella requirement and students can be considered fully immunized with a record of the disease.** Students age 13 or older are not required to have the vaccine.
7. Must be received the same day as measles, mumps, or rubella or at least 28 days apart.
