**This program is offered to King County families who are currently in any of the following situations:**

- Living in an emergency or domestic violence shelter or in transitional housing
- Living in a motel, car or park, or camping
- Moving from place to place, have no place to stay, or are being evicted within a week

**Possible reasons for needing child care and other services:**

- Working or job search
- Attending school or training
- Searching for housing
- Going to appointments related to legal, medical, and/or other social services
- Needing respite care, or child development

**We provide assistance with:** contacting DSHS for services that you are entitled to, searching for childcare programs, paying for short-term childcare, travel costs, and/or assistance with Special Needs funds.
