Dear Parents,

On Wednesday, May 28th, from 10:30-1:15, our program is sponsoring a one-day field trip for K-5 Native American/Alaska Native students to attend a cultural presentation to be held at Wilson-Pacific Site 1330 No. 90th Street, Seattle. We are hoping that your son/daughter can attend what we believe will be a most enlightening, educational, and entertaining event. We are anticipating that 200 K-5 Seattle Public Schools Native students from over 20 different schools will be participating. This day will include Native storytelling, Alaskan Native song and dance, and time for your kids to connect with other Native kids from other schools, and of course, lunch! We believe that this event will be a very positive factor in your son's/daughter's life and we strongly encourage you as parents to become involved if you can. We are currently seeking parents who can chaperone on buses to and from their schools for this event. Safety for our Title VII kids is a top priority! Shortages of chaperones can be a potential problem so it is very important that we hear from you if you can chaperone! **Sadly, if our program cannot recruit chaperones from your school, we will not be able to take students from your school on the field trip.** We will be transporting the students from their schools via chartered buses on the morning of May 28th (pick up and drop off schedules will be submitted to your school shortly.) All students will be transported after they are dropped off at their school for a regular school day, upon which time, they will be loaded onto another bus for Wilson-Pacific. We anticipate that all of the students will be dropped off back to their schools by 2:15 pm. If you can help chaperone please call our office at 252-0948.
