Order of assignment tiebreakers for . . .	Transportation
Your reference area school <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Reference Area 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Another reference area school in your cluster <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the reference area for that school 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
A reference area school outside of your cluster <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the reference area for that school 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally NOT provided unless the school is a designated out of cluster integration option* for the cluster where the student lives or is an "all-city transportation" school. Spectrum Programs <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings at the school 2 Students who live in the same cluster as the school requested 3 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the requested school is in the cluster where the student lives (or if the school is a designated out of cluster integration option* for the cluster where the student lives), and the student lives more than 1.0 mile from the school. African American Academy <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Lottery 	All-city transportation. Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
AE II <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the North and Northeast clusters 3 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
AS #1 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Lottery 	All-city transportation. Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Kimball <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the Kimball reference area 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in the Central, South, Southeast, West Seattle North or West Seattle South cluster; and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
The New School (including preschool) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the South and Southeast clusters 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Orca <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Current Whitworth students who apply to Orca as their first choice 3 Students in the Central, South, Southeast, West Seattle North and West Seattle South clusters 4 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Pathfinder <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the West Seattle North and West Seattle South clusters 3 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Salmon Bay (these tiebreakers do not apply to grades 6-8) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the North, Northeast and Northwest clusters 3 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
John Stanford International School <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the Stanford (Latona) reference area 3 Distance 4 Lottery 	All-city transportation. Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
Summit K-12 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Lottery 	All-city transportation. Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.
TOPS* <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Siblings 2 Students in the Northwest, Queen Anne/Magnolia, Central, South and Southeast clusters 3 Lottery 	Yellow school bus transportation is generally provided if the student chooses and is assigned to this school, lives in a "tiebreaker cluster" at left, and lives more than 1.0 mile from the school.

*Kindergarten only: Distance will be applied as a tiebreaker to 20% of the open kindergarten seats for applicants who list TOPS as their first choice. (Open seats are those remaining after siblings are assigned.)
