**Superintendent Goodloe-Johnson to visit
Graham Hill and Roxhill Elementary Schools
on July 26, 2007**

On Thursday, July 26, Seattle Public Schools Superintendent Goodloe-Johnson will continue her tour of schools in the Seattle School District. At Roxhill Elementary School, students in 2nd, 3rd and 5th Grade will be participating in the summer semester program. The program provides students with an extended learning opportunity during summer months while also sustaining and enhancing learning skills acquired the previous school year.

At Graham Hill Elementary School, Dr. Goodloe-Johnson will have the opportunity to see Kids Co. instructors providing an engaging curriculum for students, pre-school through 5th Grade. The program for July 23-27 focuses on fish life and the sea for the younger students while older students will be exploring the world of the fine arts through clay, beads and prints. Kids Co., a non-profit, operates seven child care programs on-site at Seattle-area elementary schools. It is one of the before and –after school providers that has agreed to align learning to the district’s academics standards.
