## **School-Family Partnership Advisory Committee seeks new members; nominations due Oct. 12**

Seattle Public Schools is seeking new members to serve on the School-Family Partnership Advisory Committee. The deadline to turn in nomination forms is Oct. 12. The committee will implement the School-Family Partnership Policy, and will advise the Superintendent on ways to most effectively involve families in teaching and learning.

The committee will begin work in late October 2007, with an initial term of office through August 2008. The team will meet one to two times per month, with the possibility of additional committee work. The group will be composed of up to 30 members (parents/guardians/family members) and will be representative of the rich diversity of Seattle Public Schools.
