Filing

A person may become a candidate for a place on the Board by filing a Declaration of Candidacy with the King County Records and Election Division not earlier than the first Monday in July June nor later than the next succeeding Friday of odd numbered years.

A person is legally qualified to become a member of the Board who is a United States citizen and a qualified voter of the School District. The person's residence must be in the Director District which is vacant or up for election, and the person must be a registered voter of the Director District. Candidates for the Board, their campaign committees, and School Board members must file reports with the Public Disclosure Commission as required by law. Members of the Board of Directors and their spouses are precluded from serving as employees of the School District except in limited circumstances as proved in RCW 42.23.030.

Primary Election

In the event that there are more than two candidates for any position on the Board, a primary election shall be held in the manner prescribed by law. Primary elections shall be by individual Districts. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes in the primary election will appear on the school election ballot the following November.

General Election

A School Board election shall be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November of the odd-numbered years. General elections for Directors shall be by voters in the entire School District.
