In accordance with statutory provision, each new Director shall take an oath to support the constitutions of the United States and the State of Washington and to faithfully discharge the duties of the office according to the best of the Director's ability. The oath will be given at the first official meeting after the election results are certified. It shall be endorsed thereon and sworn to before a notary public.

Forms for the oath of office are sent to the District by the County Division of Records and Elections with the certification of election results and are available in the office of Puget Sound Educational Service District No. 121. A School District officer shall certify to this oath and the signature of each new member. The original signed oath of office and two copies of the signed oath of office must be filed with the Educational Service District Superintendent, who shall forward the original signed oath of office to the Director of the Division of Records and Elections, in King County, and one copy of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
