At the first regular December meeting the Seattle School Board shall hold an annual organizational meeting at which it elects a president, vice president, and member-at-large to the Executive Committee to serve one-year terms. Officers are elected by a majority vote of all the members of the Board

If a majority of the Board is appointed, a new election of officers shall occur, to complete that term of office. If a Board member is unable to continue to serve as an officer, a replacement shall be elected immediately. In the temporary absence of the president, vice president, and member-at-large, the Board shall elect a president pro tempore who shall perform the function of the president during the officers' absence.

The Superintendent shall act as Secretary to the Board and will conduct the election of board members each year. In order to provide a record of proceedings of each meeting of the Board, the Superintendent shall appoint a recording Secretary of the Board.
