The President of the Board shall insure that all new Board members have the timely information necessary for orientation to the purposes, goals, and policies of the Board of Directors, its sources of authority, its responsibilities and duties, and the procedures and practices it follows for the conduct of its meetings and performance of its duties. The Superintendent will conduct a general orientation for Board candidates after the primary election. A more lengthy orientation for newly-elected Board members will be provided prior to the first regular or special meeting which they attend.

Incumbent Directors and individuals elected at the general election in November to serve as Directors are designated representatives of the District to attend the annual conference of the Washington State School Directors Association held after their election but prior to their taking office. The expenses of the representatives shall be paid by the District in the amounts and in the manner permitted by law, and the Directors shall make a conference report to the Board at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the Board in January.
