POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to abide by current copyright laws. The School Board agrees to recognize and honor all rights conferred upon authors through their lawful acquisition of valid copyrights.

No employee nor agent of the District shall make or cause to be made any duplication or other form of reproduction of an original work of authorship which is protected by copyright without first receiving permission of the copyright holder unless such duplication falls within the bounds of "fair use", as defined in the administrative procedure.

Any employees acting in violation of the District's copyright position do so at their risk and assume all liability therefore.
