POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that all students will meet or exceed achievement and performance standards at key transition points in the K-12 system before proceeding to the next level. Students with individualized education plans (I.E.P.'s) will meet or exceed specific I.E.P. objectives rather than district standards.

In addition to district and state standardized norm referenced tests, strategies will be implemented to monitor student work, assess achievement, and intervene as early as possible to accelerate progress. The Superintendent will establish specific procedural guidelines for schools to follow in addressing the educational needs of each student not progressing satisfactorily towards standards.
