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POLICY

Acknowledging the link between nutrition, lifelong health and student learning, it is the policy of the Seattle School District that nutrition education be provided to all students with the goal of improving attitude and behavior regarding nutritious food choices through a sequential and comprehensive approach.

Using culturally relevant, developmentally appropriate approaches, students will gain an understanding of the relationships among personal food choices, individual health, and environmental impact across food systems and society.

The Chief Academic Officer, or his/her designee, of Seattle Public Schools will assure compliance of this policy.
