POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that students who are known to have a life-threatening condition and who do not have a medication or treatment order in place at school shall be excluded from school until such time as the order is in place or until an independent hearing officer reinstates the student.

Upon presentation of a medication or treatment order, an Individual Health Care Plan must be developed to implement the order.

Each year, or more frequently if necessary, the parent/guardian is required to provide medication or equipment necessary to carry out the medication or treatment order, unless the District is required to provide it as a related service under federal law.
