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POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to allow school personnel to provide emergency treatment of ill and injured children and to make suggestions to parents regarding recognized home treatment for certain health conditions. The administration of oral medications by school staff is allowed upon written request of parent and licensed physician or dentist. The principal or school nurse will designate who will administer a medication. School staff will be trained and supervised by the school nurse in proper medication administration procedures.
