POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that the primary obligation of Seattle Public Schools is to serve the students who reside within the Seattle School District. If the current and anticipated needs of resident students are met, K-12 students who reside in another school district may be allowed to attend school in this District, provided that accepting the non-resident student would not disadvantage a resident student or create a financial hardship for the District, provided the student's academic and disciplinary records meet Seattle Public Schools standards, and provided that the process set forth in the accompanying Board-adopted Procedure is followed.
