POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to encourage and support a community-based system of high quality preschools and childcare programs. The Board will join with other public and community agencies to develop preschools and child care programs that meet the developmental and cultural needs of the young child and support a smooth transition into the public school system. The Board will actively cooperate with the City of Seattle and community agencies by providing space wherever possible for before and after school child care programs at schools in neighborhoods where such needs exist.
