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POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that there shall be maintained such student records as are required by law or as are necessary for the educational guidance of students or for the orderly and efficient operation of the schools, that such records are to be accurate and relevant to the student's educational welfare, that parents and adult students may inspect, review, challenge the content of student records or place statements in the record commenting on contested information, that uniform regulations and procedures shall govern the collection, maintenance, release and disposition of information and records, that the contents of student records shall be communicated only to authorized persons and that the interpretation of student records by qualified staff shall be provided whenever appropriate.
