## **PROCEDURE**

### Introduction

The Office of Counseling/Psychological/Social Work services is responsible for the development, coordination, and supervision of District activities relating to psychologists, counselors, and social workers. Office functions are divided into two main categories:

1. Counseling Services - the office has line supervision' of some of the specialized counseling projects under categorical funding. There is a staff relationship with building-assigned personnel and the office is responsible for consultation on counseling program development, in-service training, and personnel selection and certification issues. .
2. Psychological / Social Work Services - The office has line supervision of psychologists and social workers serving students with academic and/or social adjustment problems. The staff provides student assessment and evaluation for District programs requiring screening or testing for Special Education eligibility as well as short term consultation and intervention services to school staffs and to parent(s) or guardian(s).
