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POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that students with asthma or anaphylaxis are afforded the opportunity to self-administer prescribed medications. The students' parent or guardian shall submit a written request and other documentation required by the school. The student's prescribing health care provider must provide a written treatment plan.

The student shall demonstrate competence, to possess and self-administer prescribed medications during school and at school-sponsored events, to the school's professional registered nurse.

The superintendent or the superintendent's designee shall establish procedures that implement this policy and to develop emergency rescue procedures.
