PROCEDURE

Identification

Community School Programs use public school facilities, but are organized, funded, staffed, and independently operated by community members. These community schools offer a wide range of instructional, recreational, cultural, and other related community services.

The Seattle School District supports community school programs by:

1. Maintaining liaison through the Division of General Administration and District Relations.
2. Making public school facilities available to community schools on an extended schedule, and under the conditions of a building use agreement.
3. Encouraging employees to cooperate with the community school program.

Procedures

1. Refer questions about community school matters to the Division of General Administration and District Relations.
2. Refer questions about community school building and grounds use permits to Facilities -Operations.
3. Principals and program managers of buildings housing community schools:
 - a. Retain a copy of the building and grounds use agreement.
 - b. Maintain communication with the community school coordinator to coordinate community school schedules with public school activities, and approve these schedules.
 - c. Approve display or distribution of community school publicity in the school.
 - d. Exchange information and/or resolve or refer problems of mutual concern to the community school and the public school.
 - e. Require the safe and orderly operation of the building.
