POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that the Parent Teacher Student Association shall be recognized as an official channel through which parents, staff and students may unite their efforts and mutual interests through participation in school affairs. The school district shall support the parent-teacher-student association by encouraging its staff and students to join and participate in the organization's activities. In schools where there is no Parent Teacher Student Association, another parent group may be recognized by the administration. Such groups will receive the same support and encouragement accorded to the PTSA by this policy. This policy does not address governance issues.
