POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to encourage school visitation by parents, family members, and adult members of the community in order to observe the educational program, provided that only minimal disruption of the program occurs. Such visitation shall occur in conformance with specific District and administrative procedures.

Visitors whose purpose is to influence or solicit students shall not be permitted on the school grounds unless the principal or designee has determined that the visit furthers the educational program of the District or the career or educational aspirations of the student.

The policy will be implemented in conformance with the accompanying procedures and the District policy on controversial issues.
