**POLICY**

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to encourage the use of surplus space within an operating school building, both during and beyond the regular school day, at fair rental or lease rates. Such use shall not be permitted if it conflicts with the school program, as determined by the superintendent or designee, or with the existing joint use agreement between the City of Seattle, Department of Parks and Recreation and the Seattle School District. Priority consideration shall be given first to requests for joint use from childcare centers and preschools, and next to other nonprofit service and arts organizations.
