POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board to prohibit the use of all tobacco products in or on Seattle school district property, on school district-sponsored transportation, and at school district-sponsored events. Following state law, the Seattle School Board also prohibits the possession of all tobacco products by students under the age of eighteen in or on Seattle School District property, on school district-sponsored transportation, and at school district-sponsored events.

For purposes of this policy, the term "tobacco products" shall include any kind of tobacco, smoking pipe, cigar, cigarette, or any other smoking equipment or material. The term "tobacco products" shall also include all chewing or sniffing tobacco products.

The school district shall notify students and school personnel of the tobacco prohibition and post signs prohibiting the use of tobacco products. Students and school personnel who violate this policy may be subject to sanctions including, but not limited to a tobacco use diversion class, a referral for educational material on the risk of smoking, and after multiple violations, discipline.
