POLICY

It is the policy of the Seattle School Board that the total budgeted expenditures for each fund in the adopted budget shall constitute the appropriations of the District for the ensuing fiscal year and the District is limited in the incurring of expenditures to the grand total of such appropriations. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the Superintendent is authorized to make expenditures and commitments in accordance with the adopted budget.

Directors, officers, or employees who knowingly or negligently violate this section by incurring expenditures in excess of any appropriations will be held civilly liable for such expenditures.

If the District needs to increase the amount of the appropriation from any fund, for any reason, the School Board, before including such excess expenditures, shall adopt a resolution stating the facts and estimating the amount of the additional appropriation needed.
