6. Standing on a corner and shouting out someone's name, phone number, or address.	___Sending constant mean text messages and making phone calls to bully someone.
7. Stealing a DVD in a music store.	___Giving away someone's private information on MySpace, Facebook, or other social networking sites.
8. Telling something somebody told you in private to others.	___Posting a secret someone told you on a Web page.
