On the left, is a list of actions that are examples of real world bullying. On the right, is a list of similar online bullying actions. Match the two by writing the number of the real world action next to the online action.

Real-world actions	Online actions
1. Standing on a corner and shouting out someone's name, phone number, or address.	Giving away someone's private information on MySpace, Facebook, or other social networking sites.
2. Stealing a DVD in a music store.	Downloading a music file without permission.
3. Putting somebody else's quote in a book report and pretending they are your words.	Cutting and pasting material from a Web site and putting it in a report without giving credit.
4. Yelling at people and treating them with disrespect.	Sending a mean text message.
5. Stalking somebody by following them around all day and insulting them.	Sending constant mean text messages and making phone calls to bully someone.
6. Telling something somebody told you in private to others.	Posting a secret someone told you on a Web page.
7. Excluding somebody from your group when you are no longer friends.	Blocking somebody from IM and social networking spaces you and others in your group use.
8. Gossiping about somebody.	Spreading lies about someone on your blog.
