

At the June meeting site council approved:

1. The newly updated bylaws and standing rules
2. The creation of a volunteer coordinator position for the 09-10 school year
3. The 09-10 budget (Highlights include decisions made on how to distribute the Expeditionary Learning money raised at the auction; use of \$20K in carry-forward fund for \$10K of new library books, new gym mats, and a new PE storage container.)
4. The new slate of site council officers
5. Three after-school programs for the 09-10 school year: drama, chess club, and sewing. (After school programs are not limited to these. These are just what has been approved so far.)

John updated the site council on enrollment, the two part-time positions, the alternative schools meeting with the superintendent, the date for the Wedgwood Outdoor Movie (July 11th—mark your calendar!), and information about the awards ceremony for the Lincoln Center Imagination Award. He also announced that Sandra Brettler has been awarded the Patsy Collins award for environmental education through Islandwood. She will receive \$2500 for a charity of her choice.
