- Provides Panelists with significant “walk away” insight about the work of the project.
 - Provides specific examples and evidence, from weeks or months of work on project, to support insight.
 - Provides evidence that project helped to meet an authentic community need.
 - Explains how project is part of student’s vision for “beyond high school.”
