Some changes are in store for students in grades 9-12 this year that we hope will simplify and clarify your path to graduation.

Here's what you need to know:

***Wendy Kennedy** and **Connie Jacobson** will be the SLP teachers for high school students. You will be assigned to one or the other.

*The High School SLP form has been streamlined to better reflect your progress toward graduation. At the beginning of this year, complete the old SLP form before your first SLP meeting. Together we will transfer the information to the new form, so you will know how to use the new form in the future.

*Wendy and Connie will meet one-on-one with their high school students once each month. This is already a program requirement, but this year we plan to schedule the meetings, allow more time, and make the contact more meaningful by addressing class/credit progress, graduation requirements, as well as college and career counseling. Parents are required to attend the SLP meetings at the beginning of each quarter. Parents are welcome at the other scheduled meetings. If a parent cannot attend the other monthly meetings, they will be contacted by the SLP teacher either by phone or email to report student progress. We believe this increased communication will benefit everyone.

*Running Start students need only meet with their SLP teacher before they register for the following quarter community college courses. If Running Start students are taking any classes at HRC, they will need to meet with their SLP teacher once a month.
