Classes in Drama/Music Room

Before School Sessions are on Monday and Wednesday. You can choose one or both of the following options:

Monday: September 28, October 5, 12, 19, 26, November 2, 9, 16 (8 sessions)

Wednesday: September 30, October 7, 14, 21, 28, November 4, (no 11th), 18 (7 sessions)

Mondays - 8:30 to 9:15 Theatre Games and Improv. For All Ages
This will be an energy filled session to begin the day. Students will jumpstart their morning with creative exercises and imaginative play.
Cost: \$90

Wednesdays - 8:30 to 9:15 Animal Masks For All Ages
Students will create an animal mask from provided materials and will explore animal movement and interpretation.
Cost: \$90 (Includes Supply Fee)

Option: Join the after school drama classes on November 19th at 4:30 for a drama club presentation in the John Hay Library.

After School Sessions are on Tuesday and Thursday. They are grade specific.

Tuesday: September 29, October 6, 13, 20, 27, November 3, 10, 17 (8 sessions)

Thursday: October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, November 5, 12, 19 (8 sessions)

Tuesdays - 3:30 to 4:30 "Just So Stories" **Kindergarten**
Each session will begin with warm-ups and imaginative play. Students will work together to present a tale from Rudyard Kipling's Just So Stories. They will join the Thursday drama group for a presentation on November 19th.
Cost: \$95 (Includes Supply Fee)

Thursdays - 3:30 to 4:30 "Just So Stories" **1st through 2nd**

Each session will begin with warm-ups and imaginative play. Students will work together and individually to present a tale from Rudyard Kipling's Just So Stories. Older students will have individual lines. They will work with the Tuesday drama class for a group presentation.

Cost: \$95 (Includes Supply Fee)

Thursdays - 3:30 to 5:00 "Just So Stories" **3rd through 5th**

Each session will begin with warm-ups and imaginative play. Students will work together and individually to present a tale from Rudyard Kipling's Just So Stories. Each student will prepare an individual monologue. They will join with all drama classes for a group presentation.

Cost: \$140 (Includes Supply Fee)

** Please note that the Tuesday and Thursday 3:30 to 4:30 sessions can be for grades K through 2 but we would like the majority of Tuesday students to be Kindergarteners. We will adjust the classes in response to enrollment. Please indicate your preference and if you are able to do either session.

All classes are taught by Debra Fox and Allan Barlow. Debra and Allan are former John Hay parents and have taught the after school drama program for two+ years. Debra received her degree in Theatre from Doane College and has worked as a stage and production manager, as well as writing theatre study guides for elementary and secondary students. Allan has been a professional actor for 25 years and has performed with most of the major theatre companies in the Seattle area.
