The items that go into each toddler bag are:

- 2 cans tunafish
- 2 cans vegetables
- 2 cans fruit
- 1-2 boxes mac and cheese
- 1 large box whole grain cereal (ex. Cheerios)
- 100% juice, 32oz or more
- Box of either Saltines or Graham crackers

Suggestions for Thanksgiving items:

- canned vegetables
- canned fruit
- mashed potatoes
- stuffing
- broth
- canned pumpkin pie
- gravy pkt
- juice or cider
