MOST staff and volunteers will take daily attendance at each activity, and it is my student's responsibility to be in their assigned activity. I can call the MOST Coordinator (Katie Taylor or Rashida Ballard at 206.252.9135) to check on my child's attendance.

I have discussed the appropriate behavior with my child and I understand that my child must follow ALL school rules while in the program, or he/she will face discipline under normal school policy.

I release the MOST Cosponsors, their employees, volunteers, agents, directors or officers from all liability to my child or to me for any loss or damage to property or injury or death to my child, whether caused by ordinary negligence by the MOST Cosponsors or by others, and I agree not to sue them.
