WHAT? - The Madison Wellness Center is a full service health clinic that provides physical and mental health care to the students of Madison Middle School. We are designed to be "Teen Friendly". The Wellness Center is supported by the Families and Education Levy and operated by Neighborcare Health.

WHERE? - The Madison Wellness Center is located on the campus of Madison Middle School

WHY? - Our purpose is to help students do better in school by working to solve physical and mental health problems, preventing serious illness, and promoting healthy lifestyles.

WHEN? - The Madison Wellness Center is open from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Friday. The Madison Wellness Center is closed during school holidays and summer break.

WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED TO STUDENTS? - Services offered at the Madison Wellness Center include: Evaluation and treatment of common health problems—Sports Physicals—Preventive Health Care—Health Education—Immunizations—Individual and Group therapy—Coordination of Care with community health care providers—Crisis—Intervention—Community & School-Based Referrals—Anger Management—Some of the issues we address: Depression, Stress, Relationship Issues, Grief & Loss, Trauma recovery, Problem-solving, Working on goals, AND MUCH MORE!!

HOW DO I USE THE CENTER? - Students must be registered with the Madison Wellness Center in order to receive care in the Center. A completed registration form with parent or guardian signature is all you need to access all of the services offered. Students 18 years old and over can sign registration forms themselves. Students under 18 are allowed to register themselves, then can only get confidential care; reproductive health services and mental health counseling. You can schedule an appointment before or after school. Request to report slips are given for appointments during school. We will do everything possible to schedule or reschedule students so that they miss as little class time as possible. You may also use the clinic without an appointment by getting a pass from your teacher.

WHO WORKS IN THE CENTER? - The Madison Wellness Center staff includes Lydia Mora - Clinic Coordinator, Auky Van Beek - Physician Assistant, Laura Levings - Mental Health Counselor, George L. Calderon - Mental Health Counselor. They all are very professional and very "Teen Friendly".

WHAT IS THE COST? - No student will be denied services due to inability to pay. Because the Families and Education Levy covers only a portion of the cost of the Madison Wellness Center, we bill insurance companies when possible. For students who have coverage through medical coupons or a public insurance plan, we bill all services to Medicaid, and the student/family will have no out-of-pocket expenses. We assist uninsured students with Medicaid enrollment, and these students receive our health services at no cost. For students with private insurance, it is possible that parents/guardians may have some out of pocket cost, depending the type of services and on the private insurance company's policy. Not all services are subject to insurance company policies, so please call if you would like more information. Lab services for non-confidential care are billed to the student's private insurance by Lab Corp.
