- Students must pre-register and be listed on the **Club Attendance Roster** in order to participate.
- Classes are limited spaces, therefore students are placed on a first come, first serve basis.
- Be sure your choices do not conflict. If a conflict exists we will assume the first choice.
- Clubs meet from 2:30pm - 4:30pm.** Students are expected to **arrive on time, and to stay in the activity area for the duration of that clubs time.**
- Snack is provided, going off campus, such as to a store (before, during or after sessions) is not allowed.**
- The school will provide activity buses Monday - Friday,** or will give students Metro bus tokens to those needing transportation home after their activity. If a student has 3 unexcused absences (per session) in their MOST program, they will be removed from the roster and bus list.
- Students are NOT allowed to remain after school or use district transportation if they engage in an activity outside of a school-sponsored program or stay without parent permission.
