- Snack is provided, going off campus, such as to a store (before, during or after sessions) is not allowed.
- **The school will provide activity buses Monday – Thursday**, or will give students Metro bus tokens to those needing transportation home after their activity.
- Students are NOT allowed to remain after school or use district transportation if they engage in an activity outside of a school-sponsored program or stay without parent permission.
