USING THE INTERNET

The Seattle Public Schools makes available to students access to computers and the Internet. Through the Internet students may have access to databases, Web sites, and sometimes email. Students might also publish their own work on the World Wide Web. Students are expected to use computers and the Internet responsibly and for school-related purposes only.

As a condition of my right to use the Seattle Public Schools Internet service, I understand and agree with the following:

- Use of the Seattle Public Schools Internet service is a privilege. If I violate any conditions of use then that privilege may be taken away by school district administrators, and other consequences may follow.
- Use of the Internet is for school-related purposes only.
- District administrators will decide what constitutes violation of Internet policies. Violations include, but are not limited to:
 - Transmission of or deliberate access to obscene, indecent, harassing, defamatory or otherwise offensive material in any form;
 - Any deliberate attempt to harm or destroy data on any system on the Internet;
 - Unauthorized installation, storage or distribution of copyrighted software or materials;
 - Violations of district policies or federal and state laws.
- School district administrators have the right to review any material sent, mailed, or stored in District computers, including Web sites and emails. The District can edit or remove any material that it believes may be unlawful, obscene, indecent, harassing, or otherwise objectionable.
- Do not give out your name, picture, telephone number, or home address while using the Internet.
- The District does not warrant that the functions of the Internet service will meet any specific requirements you may have, or that the Internet service will be error-free or uninterrupted.
- All other related student policies are applicable. Please review the "Student Rights and Responsibilities" pamphlet.

I have read the above statements and agree to follow them. Any violations of this Agreement may result in losing my Internet privilege, and other disciplinary consequences.
