

Second Grade Supply List

- Student-size backpack
- Water bottle (Please label this)
- One box of 16 small (regular size) crayons
- Six large erasers (*Pink Pearl* style)
- Four permanent glue sticks (small size)
- One box of zip lock bags, sandwich or gallon size
- One box of Band Aids
- One 10-pack of thin *Crayola Classic Color* markers
- One 10-pack of thick *Crayola Classic Color* markers
- One thin point black Sharpie
- One thick point black Sharpie
- One box colored pencils
- One pair child-sized Friskars scissors
- Two packs sharpened Ticonderoga pencils (many brands repeatedly get chewed up by the pencil sharpener)
- Two solid - colored pocket folders
- One pad of sticky notes
- Three or more thin point dry erase markers for their white boards
- One sock to be used as a personal white board eraser

Except for the water bottle and backpack, please do NOT label any items with your child's name/ all supplies will be used communally. Some will be set aside for later in the year to use as needed.
