They collaborate and compromise with delegates from nations around the globe to compile resolutions that benefit all peoples. Of course, this is but a simulation of real politics, but as the mainstream media becomes more and more skewed to a limited agenda, a true view of world politics becomes harder and harder to grasp. MUN circumvents this limitation, as each student researches and, ultimately, becomes an expert on the country that they will represent at the conference this March.
