PARTY DETAILS

1. **What?** The 2008 Senior Graduation Night Party is an entire night of safe, drug and alcohol-free, memorable activities, food and fun for all graduating West Seattle High School seniors. This event gives students a safe and preplanned opportunity, without drugs and alcohol, to celebrate with close friends and all classmates with whom they have shared their high school days.
2. **When?** The graduation party will be held on Thursday, June 12th from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Friday, June 13th, following graduation at Memorial Stadium on Thursday, June 12th at 5 p.m.
3. **Where?** Students will meet in the West parking lot of WSHS at 10 p.m. on the night of graduation. Buses will transport students to two secret locations, and then will return students to WSHS at 6 a.m. the next morning. **Everyone rides the bus!** Lists with students' names will be posted on the outside of buses. All students need to make arrangements to have a ride home after the party.
4. **How much?** Ticket cost is \$90.00 per student (the actual cost is \$135.00). Students who qualify for a free or reduced lunch can apply for \$45.00 tickets, and some full scholarships are available. We want all students to be able to attend, whether or not they have the ability to pay. Please consider making a tax-deductible donation to the graduation party. The actual cost of the event is greater than the ticket price, so we must raise over \$6,000.00. Your donations also help us cover reduced price ticket costs.
5. To purchase a ticket, please return forms and payment to WSHS main office or mail payment and forms to: WSHS PTSA, 2008 Senior Graduation Night Party, 3000 California Ave SW, Seattle, WA 98116, or drop them off at the WSHS main office. If you have already ordered your ticket, please return the medical release/permission form only. A medical release/permission form must be completed for each student who attends the graduation party!
6. Students should wear casual clothes to the graduation party, such as tennis shoes, jeans, shorts, t-shirt or a light sweatshirt. Both venues are indoors, so no jackets are required.
7. **Everyone stays the entire night!** Once we leave WSHS, everyone stays together until dropped off at WSHS the next morning. **No in and out privileges!**
8. **Students are not allowed to bring: backpacks or bags, drugs, alcohol or cigarettes, cell phones (emergency phone available), I Pods, and food or water (will be provided).** Students will be patted down and purses will be searched.
9. **Let's show how great WSHS seniors are!** If students remember at all times that they represent themselves, their families and WSHS, there will be no conduct problems. Any student arriving at the buses under the influence of drugs or alcohol or found with drugs or alcohol will be expelled from the event. Any students jeopardizing the safety or spirit of the evening in any way will be expelled from the event, and a parent or guardian will be called to pick them up. **No ticket refunds and no exceptions!**
10. The graduation party will be chaperoned by WSHS parents and a professional security staff.
