

STUDENT ENROLLMENT CALENDAR FOR FALL 2007



PRE-REGISTRATION FOR 2007-2008

October – November 2006

Pre-register Kindergarten students and students in other grades who will enter Seattle Public Schools in September 2007. Families can pre-register in person at an Enrollment Center or the Bilingual Family Center, or by mail or fax. You'll complete a registration form and provide required documents, and we'll mail you a personalized school application in January. Then you can make school choices and apply by mail, by fax, or in person during the Open Enrollment period, January 16 – February 28, 2007. SIBLING EARLY ASSIGNMENTS FOR 2007-2008*

Entry Grades (Kindergarten, Grade 6, or Grade 9 for most schools)

October – November 2006

Students applying for the entry grade at a school a sibling attends this year, and will continue to attend next year, may submit a **Sibling Early Assignment Application** during the pre-registration period. We'll process the application at that time, and sibling early assignments for September will be mailed out mid-January (prior to the Open Enrollment period). Since sibling priority is the top "tiebreaker" for assignment to oversubscribed schools, entry grade siblings will get the same assignments as if they applied during Open Enrollment. No student is advantaged over another student – but by processing these applications ahead of time, we make the Open Enrollment period less crowded and more convenient for everyone. (*Certain restrictions apply. We recommend applying in person for this option to verify eligibility. See our web site for more details.)



OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR STUDENTS IN ALL GRADES

January 16 – February 28, 2007

Apply at any time during Open Enrollment to receive priority assignment for September 2007. Current 5th and 8th grade students going to middle or high school next year will receive an Enrollment Guide and school application form in the mail. Applications can be returned by mail, by fax, or in person. (If you don't receive mail for your 5th or 8th grader by the end of January, check with an Enrollment Center to be sure we have your current address.)
