

Condition of Usage – Metro Pass



In acceptance of this Metro Bus Pass you have agreed to adhere to the Metro Transit/Seattle Public School District Code of Conduct.

For the Safety and Comfort of All Transit Riders:

Everyone who pays his/her required fare is welcome to ride the bus. Everyone who rides the bus must respect the rights of other customers. Metro has a Code of Conduct that governs behavior on the bus and is enforced by Local and Metro Transit Police.

Any of the following behaviors while riding the bus violates Metro’s Code of Conduct. Violators may be subject to arrest, fine, ejection, suspension from Metro bus service and/or disciplinary action at school.

- Refusing to pay proper fare
- Drinking alcoholic beverages
- Radio or tape playing without earphones
- Lying down or occupying more than one seat
- Harassing driver or other riders
- Fighting or using profanity
- Littering or creating unsanitary conditions
- Vandalizing transit property
- Blocking the aisles
- Smoking
- Carrying flammable materials
- Spitting
- Hanging or swinging on bars or stanchions
- Extending an object or portion of one’s body through the door or window
